September 2021 Agenda Review*  August 2021 Minutes Review*	A copy of the September 2021 Agenda was presented for review and approval. Motion to approve the Agenda was made by Richard Benavidez with a second by Jake Bradley-Rowe. Council Staff advised that the review of Service Standard 04 and the Needs Assessment Survey Tool can be removed from the agenda as they were tabled by their respective committees for further edits. Richard Benavidez amended the Motion to
	approve the Agenda with the changes noted. Jake Bradley-Rowe seconded the Amended Motion and approved by consensus.  A copy of the August 2021 Executive Committee Minutes was presented
	for review and approval. Motion to approve the Minutes as presented was made by Richard Benavidez with a second by Jake Bradley-Rowe. Discussion noted one correction on page 2. The first line is corrected to read: Richard Benavidez advised that <i>he</i> Richard Benavidez amended the Motion to approve the Minutes with the changes noted. Jake Bradley-Rowe seconded the Amended Motion and approved by consensus with one abstention.
FY21 July Part A Fiscal Report* FY21 July Part B Fiscal	A copy of the FY21 Part A and Part B Fiscal Reports were presented for review and approval.
Report*	Part A: Expenditures should be at 41%. El Dorado is at 43.6% and Placer at 33%. Sacramento is at 33.6% for direct expenditures. Overall, direct expenditures in the TGA are 34.2%. Direct expenditures and the grantee

	expenditures are 33.03%. However, there are some outstanding provider invoices and the Fiscal Agent bills quarterly.
	Part B: Expenditures should be at 33%. Yolo is at 34.5% and Alpine/Sacramento is at 20.9% for direct expenditures. Overall, direct expenditures in the TGA are 21.8%. Direct expenditures and the grantee expenditures are 21.82%. However, there are some outstanding provider invoices and the Fiscal Agent bills quarterly.
	Motion to approve the Part A and Part B Monthly Reports as presented was made by Jake Bradley-Rowe with a second by Ronnie Miranda and approved by consensus.
FY21 July COVID Fiscal Report	A copy of the FY21 COVID Fiscal Report was presented for informational purposes. El Dorado and Placer Counties have spent 100% of their funds. Sacramento is at 26.5% for direct expenditures. Overall, direct expenditures in the TGA are 34.56%. The grantee does not receive funding from this funding source for administrative costs. Discussion included the potential need for increased direct client services as COVID-related assistance, such as the Moratorium on Rent, increased unemployment benefits and increased CalFresh benefits are ending.
State Office of AIDS – Ending the Epidemic Grant Update	The Wellness without Walls mobile van is still on track to be up and running in November. The County completed the RFP process for the Ending the HIV Epidemic Wraparound Services.
HRSA – Ending the Epidemic Grant Update	The Fiscal Agent is in the process of re-submitting the carryover request.

Committee Updates:	<b>Administrative Assessment Committee</b> (AdAC): The next meeting is scheduled for November 19, 2021. Participants must sign a Confidentiality Agreement to participate.
	<b>Affected Communities Committee</b> (ACC): Richard Benavidez informed that Reflectiveness is presently at 42.3%. Members of ACC participated in Recovery Happens and ran out of Council brochures.
	<b>Priorities and Allocations Committee</b> (PAC): The Priorities and Allocations Committee was scheduled to meet in September to discuss Reallocation. Unfortunately, the Fiscal Agent advised that due to insufficient and incorrect responses from Providers, a recommendation is not possible by the date of the PAC meeting. Additionally information is needed from several providers. The Executive Committee agreed that the Fiscal Agent should wait and submit the recommendation at Council as Council has the final vote anyway. As such, PAC will not be meeting in September.
	<b>Quality Advisory Committee</b> (QAC): Richard Benavidez advised that QAC met and began reviewing Service Standard 04: Support Services. QAC tabled the item as there were additional changes suggested.
	<b>Needs Assessment Committee</b> (NAC): Ronnie Miranda advised that NAC met and began reviewing the Needs Assessment Survey Tool. NAC tabled the item as there were additional changes suggested.
Sacramento TGA Bylaws	<b>Governance</b> (Gov): Council Staff advised Michael Ungeheuer was unable to attend the meeting to address concerns with the Bylaws. The matter was tabled until the next meeting.
